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**Glacier National Park - In summer 2025, an additional vehicle reservation will be required during peak times of 7am-3pm for these areas of the park:
Going-to-the-Sun Road (West) and the North Fork.**

Vehicle reservations can only be booked by visiting: <https://www.recreation.gov/timed-entry/10087086>

The entry time blocks for Going-to-the-Sun Road and the North Fork will be in two-hour increments; 7am to 9am, 9am to 11am, 11am to 1pm, and 1pm to 3pm.

Visitors who miss their reserved time block or do not have a reservation can enter after 3pm.

Visitors will be able to access the Going-to-the-Sun Road from the east side at St. Mary and Two Medicine without a vehicle reservation. The park is open 24/7 and visitors may enter vehicle reservation areas before 7am or after 3pm without a vehicle reservation.

What You Need June 13 through September 28 timed entry vehicle reservations are required for the west side of Going-to-the-Sun Road and North Fork from 7 am to 3 pm. Visitors entering the park in a vehicle or on a motorcycle in one of these areas during these dates need two things: (1) A timed entry vehicle reservation OR service reservation and (2) Park Entrance Fee OR valid Park Pass (Annual, Senior, Military, etc.). See details for Entrance Fees and Passes below. When purchasing a Park Pass on Recreation.gov, you do not need to enter a plate number for rental vehicles. On the "Vehicle Type" selection, scroll down and select "Rental Vehicle." The "License Plate Number" box will automatically autofill with "N/A".

The park is open 24/7 and visitors may enter vehicle reservation areas before 7am or after 3pm without a vehicle reservation.

Already Booked an Activity? Visitors with commercial activity reservations (e.g., boat tours and horseback rides) within the specified reservation areas can use proof of their reservation for entry instead of a vehicle reservation to gain access to the vehicle reservation area for which they have a service reservation.

Vehicle Reservation Release Dates A portion of vehicle reservations will be available 120 days or approximately four months in advance, starting on February 13, 2025, at 8am MST on a daily rolling basis. Next Day vehicle reservations will be available at 7pm MDT for next-day entry starting on June 12, 2025 on a daily rolling basis. Pursuant to the American Indian Religious Freedom Act of 1978, vehicle reservations are not required for tribal members throughout the park.

Visiting Glacier National Park in summer 2025?

Between the hours of 7 am and 3 pm, visitors need a timed entry vehicle reservation in addition to an entrance fee or pass to enter vehicle reservation areas.

Arrive at the park on your selected date with a screenshot or printout. Cell service is limited.



Already booked an activity?

Visitors with lodging, camping, or commercial activity reservations (ex. boat tours and horseback rides) can use their service reservation to access the portion of the park for which they have a reservation.

GLACIER NATIONAL PARK ENTRY FEES: 7-day entrance permit winter rates are approximately \$35 per private vehicle or \$20 for each visitor entering by foot. Remember to plan ahead, travel and recreate responsibly and leave no trace.

Be aware that cell service is limited or nonexistent in the park.

The Lodge at Whitefish Lake is located approximately 20 minutes from Glacier Park International Airport (FCA) (15 minutes). Other gateway cities are Missoula, MT (MSO) 132 miles; Spokane, WA (GEG) 261 miles; Calgary, Alberta, Canada (YYC) 293 miles.

The Lodge at Whitefish Lake provides transportation for guests traveling via Whitefish Amtrak depot OR the Glacier Park International Airport. Please schedule with the hotel directly at least 24-hours in advance for timely service: (406) 863-4000, (877) 887-4026, frontdesk@lodgeatwhitefishlake.com

The Lodge has an underground parking garage, Tesla charging station, alternative electric car charging station, and on-site parking for guests.
